SCHOOL UNIFORM

It is Omagh High School's policy that all pupils should wear the school uniform in a neat, clean and tidy fashion. Every item of clothing should be clearly labelled with the pupil's name.

Parents are encouraged to check the general appearance of their children each morning, in compliance with the following regulations.

Boys' Uniform

- 1. Outdoor coat should be either a long or short black rain coat. Parents are encouraged to purchase the jacket with the school crest.
- 2. A black blazer with the school crest must be worn.
- 3. Only the recognised school scarf may be worn.
- 4. Black school shoes. (Trainers are not permitted) Grey or black socks. (Not white)
- 5. White shirt with school tie approx 30 cm. (Top button must be fastened)
- 6. Mid-grey trousers.
- 7. Mid-grey, 'V' necked, long-sleeved jumper.
- 8. Garments worn under shirt must be white.
- 9. Hair should be clean, tidy and of moderate length and of a conventional style and colour.
- 10. Badges must be confined to **school** badges e.g. House, Prefect, Librarian and one charity badge. Belts must be simple in design.
- 11. Only one pair of studs may be worn, one in each lower ear lobe. No facial jewellery including tongue piercing is permitted. A watch may be worn. For safety reasons no other jewellery is permitted.

Girls' Uniform

- 1. Outdoor coat should be either a long or short black rain coat. Parents are encouraged to purchase the jacket with the school crest.
- 2. A black blazer with the school crest must be worn.
- 3. Only the recognised school scarf may be worn.
- 4. Black shoes. (Trainers are not permitted) White socks or black tights.
- 5. Mid-grey school regulation pleated skirt.

- 6. Mid-grey trousers. (Only one approved school style)
- 7. White shirt and school tie approx 30 cm. (Top button must be fastened)
- 8. Garments worn under shirt must be white.
- 9. Mid-grey, 'V' necked long-sleeved jumper. (Not a cardigan)
- 10. Make up is not permitted. Hair must be clean, tidy, of a conventional style and colour. (Hair accessories to be discreet)
- 11. Badges must be confined to **school** badges e.g. House, Prefect, Librarian and one charity badge.
- 12. Only one pair of studs may be worn, one in each lower ear lobe. No facial jewellery including tongue piercing is permitted. A watch may be worn. For safety reasons no other jewellery is permitted.

- 1. Black polo shirt with school crest
- 2. Black shorts
- 3. Black football socks with white piping
- 4. Trainers

Girls PE/Games Kit - Years 9, 10, 11, 12 & 14

- 1. White or Black polo shirt with school crest
- 2. Black sports skirt/shorts/skort
- 3. White socks
- 4. Trainers
- 5. Shinpads
- 6. Mouthguard

Optional Items

Girls' PE/Games Kit – New (Compulsory for Years 8 & 13)
