FOOTWEAR REGULATIONS

(for all pupils Years 8 – 14)

School shoes are an expensive part of school uniform. This leaflet provides guidance for parents and pupils regarding acceptable types of footwear as part of the everyday uniform. This is to prevent parents having to replace shoes which have been purchased but do not meet the school regulations.

FOOTWEAR REGULATIONS FOR GIRLS

- Shoes should be flat **plain black** polished leather.
- They may lace up, slip on or have Velcro fastening however they must be in the traditional school style.
- Canvas, suede, nu-buck or 'fashion' shoes are not permitted.
- Soles must be black.
- Trainer type shoes and boots are not permitted.

If in doubt, parents should contact school **BEFORE** purchasing shoes.

FOOTWEAR REGULATIONS FOR BOYS

- Shoes should be flat **plain black** polished leather.

- Trainer type shoes and boots are not permitted.
